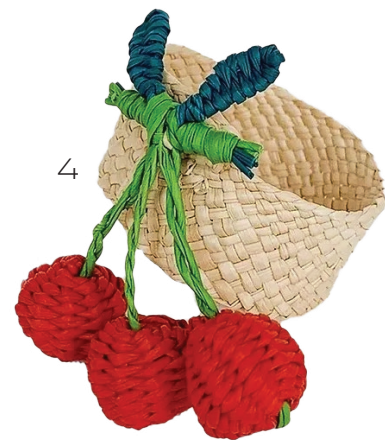

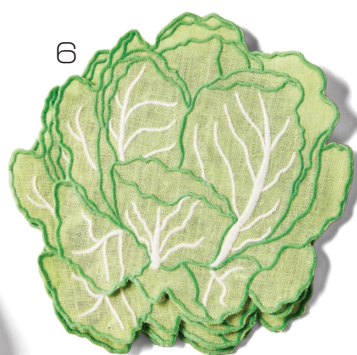
The sun-ripened hues, organic details, and pleasingly familiar shapes of fruits and vegetables are making for a bumper crop of tempting home accessories this spring.
